Eligibility is based on the below criteria. ***NEW** Placement for a solo, duet, trio or quartet will be determined by POINTS in categories for Tests/Competitions, Participation, Performance & Sportsmanship. Eligibility: (ALL ITEMS must be checked to be eligible for a Specialty Number and approved by the Skater's Parent)

- Skater must pass the Gold Free Skate level through the Eagan Skate School by Winter 2023 (or Spring 2024 w/coach approval)
- Skater must be in private lessons with an Eagan Skate School Instructor and/or an Eagan Ice Crystal FSC Coach at least 15 minutes per week through Fall, Winter and Spring. May utilize the Practice Ice w/Lesson.
- Skater must enroll and **actively participate* in an Eagan Skate School **Free Skate class** in **Fall**, Winter & Spring sessions
**actively participate* is defined as participating AND attending on time at least '5 of 8' skate school classes per session
- Skater must register through the City of Eagan for a Group Number in the Annual Spring Ice Show and must attend, participate and perform in their Group Number.
- Skater must demonstrate **exceptional** sportsmanship towards parents, volunteers, coaches and other skaters AT ALL TIMES.

Skater/Parent Agreement: (Please read, check and sign)

- Skater/Parent understands that all props, costumes & coaching fees are the responsibility of the skater for the Specialty Number.
- Skater/Parent understands that music, props and costumes will be chosen/approved by the Show Committee for every number including Specialty Numbers as well as Solos for the integrity of the overall show production.
- Skater will commit to participating in ALL rehearsals. **Absences must be approved PRIOR to placements.**
- Parent must be available to volunteer at **one** show (Locker Room Monitors, Spotlights, Tickets, Merchandise Sales, etc)
- Skater (12 years of age or older) must be available to volunteer with Set/Props for at least 3 hours**
- Skater/Parent will attend a mandatory Specialty Number show meeting**
- Skater/Parent understands that failure to provide truthful information of eligibility and requirements, having absences from rehearsals or show performances, demonstrating unbecoming behavior towards a skater, parent or coach or speaking negatively about the show or its skaters may result in removal from the show entirely as well as future show eligibility with no refund.
- Skater/Parent understands that no skater is guaranteed or entitled to a solo performance.**
- Specialty Numbers including Solos must be choreographed by an Eagan Skate School Instructor only.
