PETITION TO DESIGNATE A WINTER PARKING SCHEDULE

Background: The City-wide odd/ even parking restrictions have worked very well to allow for safe and efficient snow removal and to identify abandoned or disabled vehicles. However, it turns out that there are numerous areas in Eagan that have either all-even or all-odd addresses on both sides of the street. This unintentionally bans any on-street parking every-other-day in those areas from November 15 - April 15 (6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.). To ease that inconvenience, the City Code has been amended to allow the City Council to make changes through the petition process.

Process: Residents in neighborhoods where the houses are either all even-numbered or all odd-numbered who want to change parking restrictions can submit a Petition to the City Council which contains the signatures of at least 51% of the affected property owners. The Petition is returned to the City Engineer for review. If there are no negative impacts to public safety, it will then be presented to the City Council. If the City Council grants the Petition, street signs noting when and where parking is allowed will be installed at no cost to the affected property owners.
