What is Adopt-A-Storm Drain?

This program is a public service opportunity for volunteers to help prevent stormwater pollution. Residents, groups, and businesses clean up gates of storm drains and surrounding areas.

Why get involved?

Rain or snowmelt washes dirt, yard waste, trash, or other pollutants into storm drains, and eventually into lakes and wetlands. By adopting a storm drain, you can help prevent pollution before it reaches nearby water bodies.

More volunteer opportunities

Storm drain labeling

Help spread the message “Keep Pollutants Out, Drains to Lake” by gluing curb markers near street storm drains to remind residents about the connection between their lots and healthy lakes and wetlands.

Lake cleanup
